The Ysleta Teachers PAC collect voluntary contributions from Association members and use those contributions for political purposes including, but limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for the Ysleta school board trustees. Contributions to Ysleta Teachers PAC are voluntary; making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. A member may contribute any amount, or nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights or benefits in the Ysleta Teachers PAC.

Contributions or gifts to the Ysleta Teachers PAC are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer of individuals whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Federal law prohibits the YPAC from receiving donations from persons other than members of the NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of YPAC and its affiliates and their immediate families will be returned forthwith.
